1. **Please contact the lab before sending whole tubers** to ensure availability of service—we are limited by space and labor in our ability to accommodate whole tubers.
2. We will accommodate requests for reduced core subsamples for *Dickeya* testing in place of the 200 core subsample, and can bulk the smaller subsamples into a composite sample for 1 BRR test per 200 cores. In this case, each test would have the stand-alone pre-cored price, with a \$10 fee per 200 tubers cored by the CSU PDC.
3. Price may be lower if subsample size is below 200 cores. If a reduced subsample size is requested, a \$10 fee will be applied per 200 tubers cored by the CSU PDC.
