### Proposal: Merge college print management with campus system

The college of Agricultural Sciences and the Morgan library have been using the same print management software for three years (Paper Cut). We propose that the accounts be merged to give more flexibility and reduce confusion for our students.

#### Existing system

- Students receive print credit each semester
- After credit is exceeded, students go to the college business office with cash to buy additional credit
- Printers in the Morgan library are on a separate system that students charge to their RAMCard

#### Proposal

- College and university print management accounts merged this summer
- A one-time transfer to the university student accounts made from our tech fees of \$10 per student for the fall semester, 2014
- Students pay as you go using RAMCard once their credit runs out

#### Why is this being proposed?

- Students can print to and from multiple locations on campus under the same system
- Students use a single system – less confusion
- The majority of students leave the university with excessive unused print credit balances
