

2013 Green & Gold Showdown Rules

Junior Show will be a one day show, heifers will start the show on Sunday, March 18th and the market animal show will follow directly after the female show. Both breeding heifers and market animals will have the option to show in one or both rings. A two ring system will be used with a different judge in each of the A ring and B ring. Animals must be entered to show in each of the two rings.

This will be a prospect show. Breeding heifers must be born on or after Sept. 1, '11 and all market animals must be born on or after Jan. 1, '12. Steers and market heifers will be weighed and classes will be broken by weight. New this year, there will be breed shows for the market animals. Breeding Heifer classes will be broken by age and breed.

Youth show entries will be allowed on the grounds starting at 12:00 p.m. on Friday, Mar. 15th and must be on the grounds by 12:00 p.m. on Saturday Mar. 16th. Check in will be Saturday March 16th from 7:00 a.m. to 10:00 a.m.

There will be a showmanship contest following the Blackout show at approx. 4:00 p.m. on Saturday. Exhibitors must be a 4-H, FFA or Breed Association Members. Any exhibitor who was 21 years of age before January 1, 2013 is ineligible to show. Exhibitors must show their own animal unless they have more than one animal in a single class.

In the female show, breeds must have at least seven head to represent a breed division. If fewer than seven are entered, that breed will show as AOB. All heifers must be registered in the name of the junior exhibitor only.

Registration papers must be presented at the show (only for the breeding show). Heifers entering the AOB class must be registered heifers (not commercial). There will be a commercial heifer division offered.

The Green and Gold committee has decided to have breed shows for the market animal show this year. The exhibitor will classify their own animals in the designated breed shows already solidified by the committee (find list below); animals that do not classify during weigh in will be shown in the crossbred division.

BE SURE TO DESIGNATE BREED ON ENTRY FORM!!!!

Animals with lesions of ringworm, warts or infested with mange will be excused from the premises.

The Green and Gold Showdown Executive Committee will have final ruling on interpretation of all rules.
