Criteria

Declared Major:	School of Ag/Animal Science, School of Business/Economics, College of Engineering
Classification:	Graduating High School Senior
Grade Point Average:	3.0 Cumulative or above

Required Documentation

1. Submit a resume demonstrating academic excellence, leadership record, community and extracurricular activities.
2. Submit official transcript showing GPA of 3.0 or higher and classification.
1. Submit one page statement of **“If you had the power to change something in the current state of agriculture, what would you change and why?”**
3. Three letters of recommendation- (including one letter from your MANRRS Advisor)
4. Copy of the acceptance letter of the school you will be attending in Fall 2017.

Selection Process

1. John Deere will review and select student based on the above criteria.
2. **Submit application to John Deere – MANRRS at JDMANRRSMailbox@JohnDeere.com by March 15, 2017.**
3. The John Deere Scholarship will be awarded at the 32nd MANRRS National Training & Development Conference.
