It is my pleasure to send you this important information about The Honor Society of Phi Kappa Phi Fellowship competition. We would appreciate if you could make this information available in your office.

The Phi Kappa Phi Fellowship program awards \$345,000 annually to 57 Fellowship recipients:

- 6 Fellowships at \$15,000 each
- 51 Fellowships at \$5,000 each

The Fellowship program is designed to provide support to Active (dues current) Phi Kappa Phi members as they prepare to enter their first year of graduate or professional studies in the upcoming 2013 academic year. One requirement is that the applicant may **not** have already earned more than nine (9) semester hours of graduate/professional school credits by application the deadline date of April 15, 2013.

ABOUT FELLOWSHIPS

Every year, The Honor Society of Phi Kappa Phi awards 51 Fellowships of \$5,000 each and six at \$15,000 each to members entering their first year of graduate or professional study. Each Phi Kappa Phi chapter may select one candidate from among its local applicants to compete for the Society-wide awards.

HOW TO APPLY

Go to PhiKappaPhi.org/Fellowships to access an online application and review submission instructions.

SELECTION CRITERIA

Selection is based on the applicant's promise of success in graduate or professional study, including academic achievement, service and leadership experience, letters of recommendation, personal statement and career goals, and acceptance at an approved graduate or professional program.

ELIGIBILITY

Open to all active Phi Kappa Phi members or those who have accepted membership by June 30, 2013, and:

- Have applied to enroll as a full-time student in a post-baccalaureate program of study during the coming academic year.

Please note: Students registering in all professional and graduate fields are eligible.

- Applicants who have successfully completed 10+ credit hours of graduate study or its equivalent on or before April 15 are NOT eligible.

DEADLINE

Contact your chapter for application deadline information. Chapters may submit one application to Society headquarters by April 15, 2013. Recipients will be notified by June 1, 2013.
