

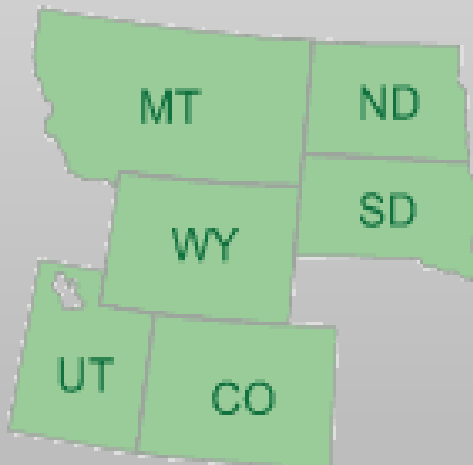

# Utah SIPM Workshops - What the District and Public Health Organization Employees will learn?

- ▶ Understand the basics of the Utah Health Department's R392-200-7(12)
- ▶ Understand the principals and practices of School Integrated Pest Management
- ▶ Practical hands-on training on how to implement and effective School IPM program in their districts
- ▶ Understand the mandates that are required under the school rule and enforcement measures that could be used to encourage compliance of the school IPM rule.

# Utah Agencies with oversight for Implementation of Utah SIPM RULE

- ▶ Primary oversight; Utah Department of Health
- ▶ Secondary support; Utah Coalition of School IPM comprised of Utah State University Extension, Salt Lake City School District, Salt Lake County Health, Utah Asthma Program, and the Utah Department of Agriculture and Food.
- ▶ Other supporting agencies; Utah State Office of Education. The Coalition partnered with the USOE to distribute the information about the R392-200 changes, and the USOE also encouraged all upper administration to make sure that key players within the districts that would have a role in the implementation of the IPM program attend the training.

# EPA's Role in Utah School Rule Implementation

- ▶ The Region 8 office and Center of Expertise for School IPM will provide resources and technical support as requested
- ▶ EPA educational resources will be used to support the SIPM training for the Districts and Public Health officials

- ▶ The Wyoming Department of Agriculture and the University of Wyoming has signed a cooperative agreement allowing John Connett, School IPM Specialists at the University to advance SIPM in Wyoming.
- ▶ The agreement is funded through the U.S. Environmental Protection Agency 2015 - 2017 State workplan agreement with the Wyoming Department of Agriculture.
- ▶ This effort brings with it an opportunity to advance the School IPM initiative in Rural schools in Region 8.
