Pesticide Applicator Licensing

- Who **Must** Have a License?
 - Anyone Using a Restricted Use Pesticide

Pesticide Applicator Licensing



- What is a Restricted Use Pesticide?
 - The USEPA Classifies some pesticides (insecticide, herbicide, rodenticide) as Restricted Use Pesticides
 - Usually due to a particular hazard (environmental, human, etc.)



Pesticide Applicator Licensing

- Why is a pesticide applicator license required to apply an RUP?
 - EPA has determined that additional knowledge or training is required to be considered competent to apply the pesticide

Pesticide Applicator Licensing

- How do I become a license pesticide applicator
 - Obtain pesticide application experience
 - Take CDA's exams
 - Pay the license fee



Pesticide Applicator Licensing

- Anyone applying General Use Pesticides is not required to obtain a pesticide applicator license

Pesticide Applicator Licensing

- Why would I or should I get an applicator's license if I use General Use Pesticides?
 - To show that you have a higher level of knowledge / experience of pesticide applications
 - Adds credibility to your program
 - Being licensed may reduce insurance costs
