**Minimum Requirements**

- Total of 36 credits required
  - 24 credits earned at CSU; 21 of which must be earned after admission to Graduate School
  - Minimum of 10 credits of 500-level or above agriculture coursework –
    - Prefixes include: AGED; AGRI; ANEQ; AREC; BSPM; HORT; LAND; or SOCR
  - Maximum of 6 credits of 300- or 400-level coursework related to program of study may be taken with prior approval by the advisor
  - A maximum number of 6 credits collectively AGRI 587A and/or AGRI 587B; AGRI 695 and AGRI 698 can be taken.

*Additional courses may be required, depending upon the student's preparation for graduate-level coursework. Such courses, considered prerequisite or supplementary to the graduate program, will not contribute to the minimum of 30 hours outlined above.*
