Our research efforts extend across the entire campus and state-

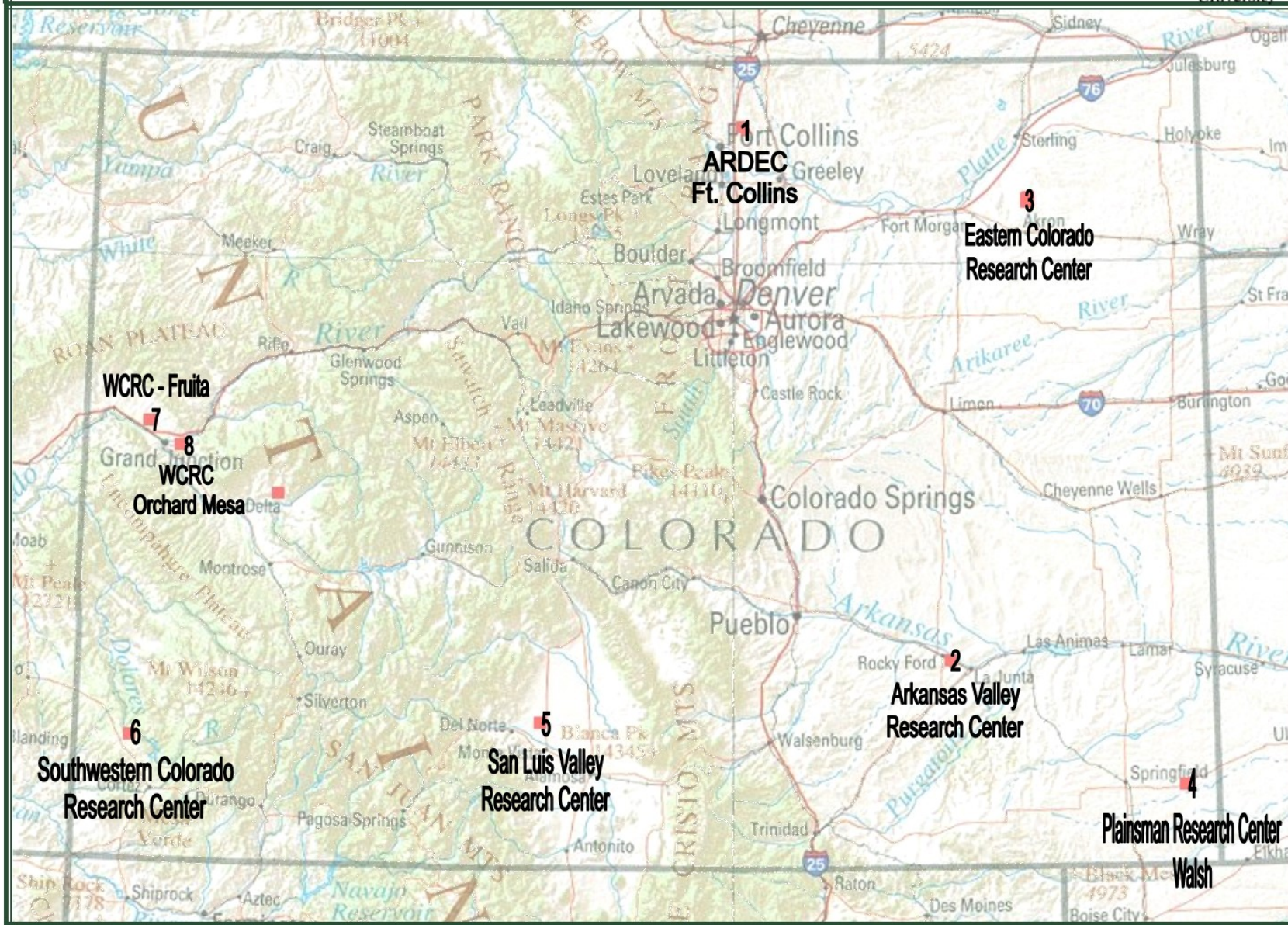
- Collaboration in 7 of 8 colleges

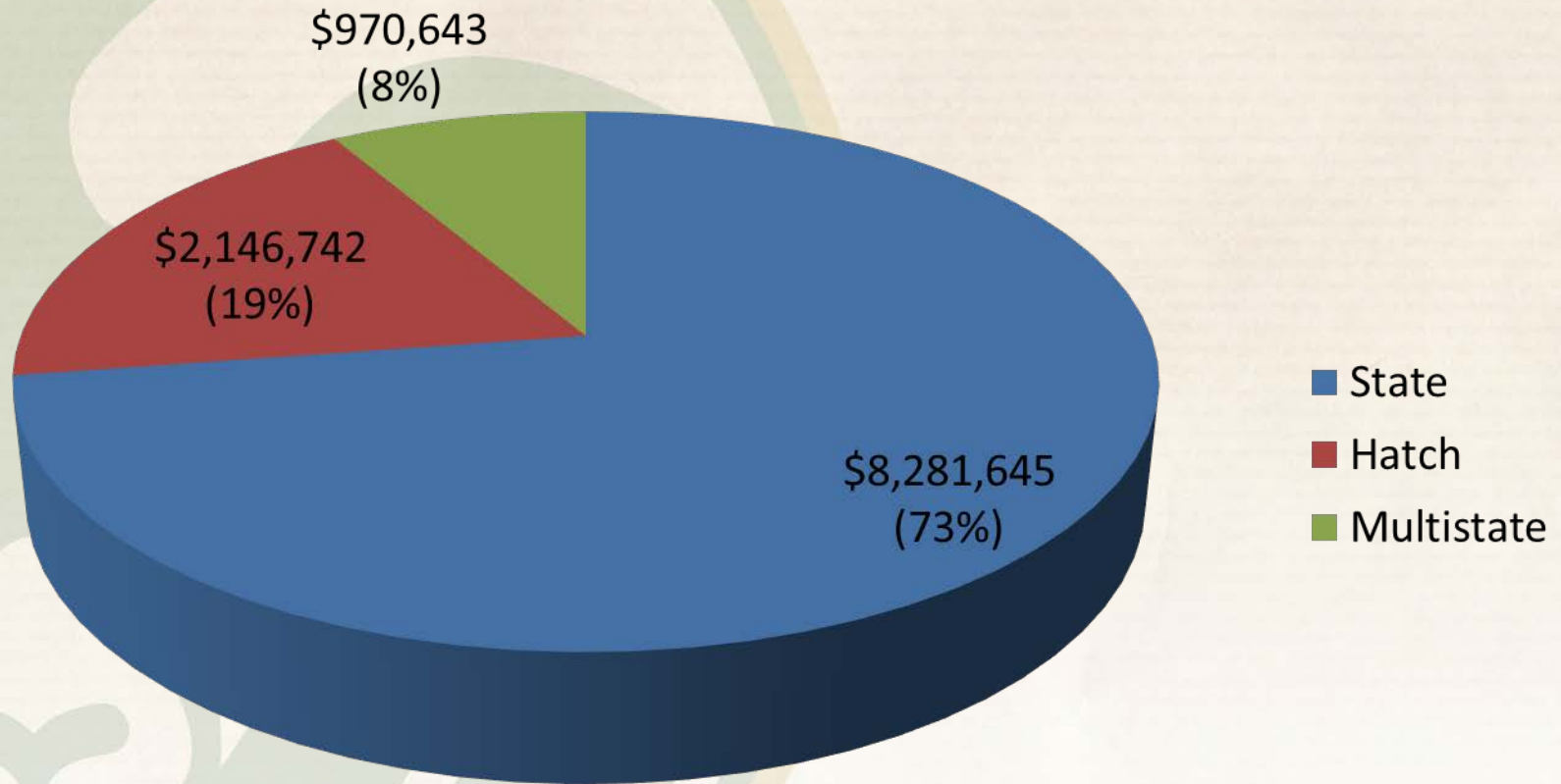

Total AES Funds by Type FY15

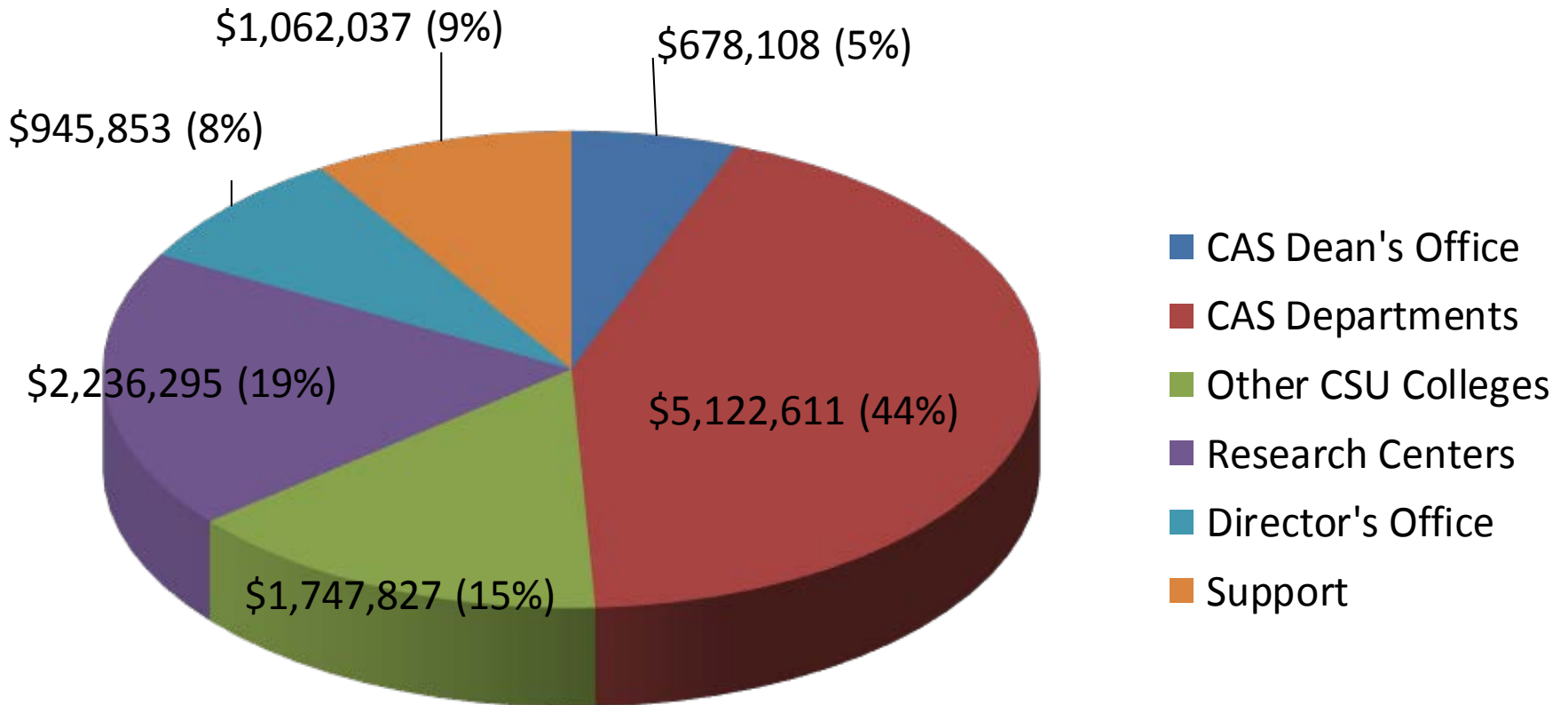
